Jean-Philippe gave a great presentation on Landscapes which was followed by a discussion on,

"Definition of a landscape", "when is a landscape not a landscape?" (If that makes sense), what is a seascape? what if an image is about 50/50 land and sea?, what about if it's mostly a lake or a river?, do street scapes fit in? etc. Can you have a landscape taken in the city?
