

Learn what your camera can do.

YouTube could help

- Quick opening of camera
- Focus
- Adjust Exposure
- Lock Focus
- Burst Mode and Select
- Use volume control buttons & Earphones to take photos in iPhone and some others
- Crop and straighten in your phones inbuilt software

Get APPS for the functions your phone does not have built in e.g. Slow Shutter Speed.

Experiment with **Large Depth of Field**
Try **auto focus** for land/sea scapes (i.e. do not tap the screen).

Others need to get an app.
eg Slow Shutter Cam for iPhone,

Shoot in Manual, if your phone has it or get an apps eg Pro Camera, Camera +, VSCO and Lightroom mobile
